The average monthly income for a family of three accessing food pantries in the Second Harvest Foodbank of Clark, Champaign and Logan Counties network was \$740 or 8,880 yearly. 94% have monthly incomes below the Federal Poverty Level; an income below \$1,375.

Only 70% of the population served by the foodbanks's partner agencies receive Food Stamps, although all appear to be categorically eligible. Their monthly Food Stamp allotment average \$192.10 or \$6.40 daily.

- 31% were children under 18 years old
- 51% were adults between 18 and 59
- 18% were seniors age 60 and older
- 21% include at least one adult working in some capacity
- 13% indicated this was their first time at the pantry while 15% access services provided at least ten to 12 times a year
- 12% reported they attended college or a two-year technical school to further their education
