The average monthly income for a family of three accessing food pantries in the Toledo Northwestern Ohio Food Bank network was \$874 or \$10,488 yearly. 92% have monthly incomes below the Federal Poverty Level; a monthly income below \$1,375.

Only 51% of the population served by the foodbank's partner agencies receive Food Stamps, although all appear to be categorically eligible. Their monthly Food Stamp allotment average \$143.79 or \$4.79 daily.

- 30% were children under 18 years old
- 44% were adults between 18 and 59
- 26% were seniors age 60 and older
- 26% include at least one adult working in some capacity
- 5% indicated this was their first time at the pantry while 18% access services provided at least ten to 12 times a year
- 17% reported they attended college or a two-year technical school to further their education
